

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF FOREST HOME CEMETERY

- No trees, shrubs or bushes shall be planted, except arbor vitae trees will be allowed, which may be planted only on either end of the stone, as close to the base as possible.
- No rose bushes are allowed.
- Planting of flowers is allowed, limited to the length of the headstone. Sod must be removed from the planting area.
- All pots, baskets, flower boxes, etc. shall be placed on either end of stone.
- All plastic flowers must be in a container, and cannot be pushed into the ground or placed on top of container or headstone.
- No glass containers or breakable figures or statues.
- Winter decorations will be allowed from December 1st to April 1st. By April 1st, all decorations must be removed, allowing for spring clean-up. All items remaining after April 1st are subject to removal and disposal by Cemetery staff. Graves may be redecorated beginning May 1st.
- Summer decorations will be allowed from May 1st to October 15th. By October 15th, all decorations must be removed, allowing for fall clean-up and winter maintenance. All items remaining after October 15th are subject to removal and disposal by Cemetery staff. Graves may be redecorated beginning December 1st.
- The Cemetery will not be responsible for any damage done to any decorations placed on graves.
- If anything placed on lots shall be injurious to people or machinery, or violates any rule, it will be removed without notice.
