Sonny agreed that it helped to include the restaurant with the golf.

Dan noted that the ladies tournament went very well, and he hoped to get them back again.

C. Grounds/Facility Report, Joe Andersen

Joe reported that no more fuel has been stolen from the golf carts since the last meeting. They will start staining the clubhouse when the busy season is over.

The waterfall blew up again and the motor has been repaired. The wiring in the panel may be compromised and will be costly to repair.

Joe noted that if need be, he could bring the golf course budget in at lower dollars, but every golfer would notice. Tom Kelly felt that if this was done, people would go somewhere else to golf. Dan noted that July should be \$150,000 month for the golf course.

Four golf carts will be used for the Oneida County Fair.

Joe said that the road into the golf course is very nice, and he noted that Randy Knuth's Public Works crew did a great job.
