- **Prospect (Bruner to Arbutus) Until Wednesday, September 11th**

***Residents will not be allowed to drive over the newly installed concrete curb, sidewalk or approaches for a minimum of 7 days to allow for concrete cure time. Vehicles should be moved to a side street prior to pouring concrete and will only be allowed back into the property after the concrete has cured.***

***RESIDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS, REQUIRING ACCESS TO THEIR DRIVEWAYS DURING THIS PERIOD, SHOULD CALL THE ENGINEER TO DISCUSS POSSIBLE ACCOMMODATIONS.***





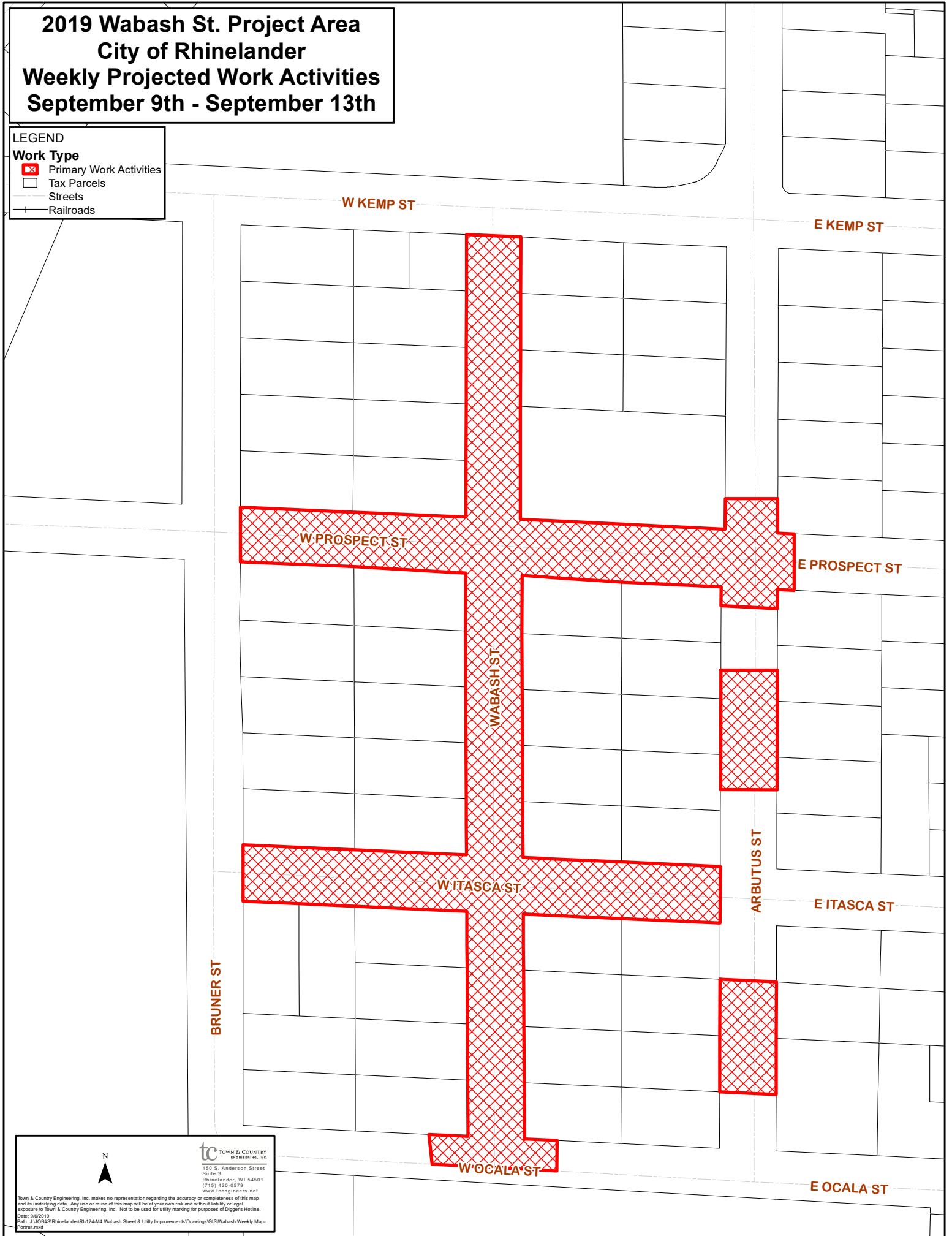
